Coulibaly had no contact with other jihadist in Madrid

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USPA NEWS - The investigation of the terrorist movements Amedy Coulibaly made in Spain between December 31 and January 2 seems not reveal anything unusual, according to the Spanish police. The officers in charge of the investigation consider that the jihadist just spent a few hours in Spain.

Just the time it took a drive to the airport in Madrid to dismiss his wife Hayat Boumedienne, and three others, family alleged Coulibaly, who flew to Istanbul way of Syria. Then Coulibaly also returned to Paris. Confirmed these facts, researchers believe that the terrorist, who days later killed five people in two violent actions in Paris, had no contact with any cell in Spain support jihadism. Counterterrorism experts say the behavior of Coulibaly and his companions is not strange. Often supporters of the Islamic State and al-Qaeda who want to travel to Syria or Iraq do from a country other than that in which they reside, and always with a stopover in Turkey, in order to avoid suspicion.

A Hayat Boumedienne they captured the security cameras from Istanbul on January 8, when he was preparing to travel to Syria and while in Paris the events that led seventeen dead, besides the three terrorists, following the attack unfolded the Charlie Hebdo magazine and a Jewish supermarket. But the investigation remains open, says the Spanish Police.

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
